2000-2006 PROGRAMMING PERIOD

OPEN CALLS FOR PROPOSALS

Bottom up approach
Lack of tools to orientate project applicants
Difficulties in achieving programme objectives

ONE STEP PROCEDURE

High level of risk for project applicants
Submission of complete application package

At the end of the programming period, some programmes experimented new procedures

2007-2013: STRATEGY

To raise QUALITY OF PROJECTS for more strategic and concrete achievements

- combination of bottom up and top down approach
- use of different procedures to better steer the implementation process
- more support and orientation in project generation phase

CAPITALIZATION OF EXPERIENCE!

NEW PROCEDURES

From OPEN CALLS to TARGETED CALLS

- focussing on relevant programme priorities
- narrowing the scope: topics, beneficiaries
- generation of strategic projects
- Terms of Reference
- thematic seminars

NEW PROCEDURES

From ONE STEP to TWO-STEP PROCEDURE

- pre-selection on the basis of a simplified form (Expression of Interest)
- final selection on the basis of the complete application package (invited projects only)
- more support from programme bodies
