The NATREG Project, which is running from March 11th 2009 until July 31st 2011, is connecting six protected areas in the South East Europe territory, namely in Austria, Croatia, Italy, Serbia and Slovenia. Project is addressing the challenge of protected areas, which represent an important instrument of biodiversity conservation, not jet being recognized as a great potential for social and economic development. It's main objective is to establish a transnational and multisectoral cooperation network and to develop the Joint Strategy for Integrated Management of Protected Areas.

We would like to announce the NATREG Final Conference, which will take place from Wednesday, June 22nd, to Friday, June 25th, 2011 in Novi Sad in Vojvodina Province in Serbia.

Conference will be held in English and Serbian language with option of simultaneous translation.

We kindly ask you to confirm your presence at the Conference, where there will be plenty of opportunity to meet strong opinion leaders, decision makers and people from the highest places in a political field.

OPTIONAL DAY VRŠAC REGION AND WINE ROUTE

Programme

Programme includes visit to Vršac city, Episcopal and Roman Catholic cathedral, the Wine Route (visit to Vršac vineyards, wine cellars with wine tasting, Banat style breakfast and lunch with sound of traditional music).

1. Arrival in Vršac in the morning:

Vršac –"beautiful Banat town" and its environment are known as the wine-growing region since the Roman rule. The landscape, which connects plains and Vršac mountains, is the spiritual headquarters of the South Banat.







2. Visit: Bishop's Palace in Vršac:



Banat Eparchy Bishop's Palace was built between the 1750th and 1757th, done in the baroque style. In the inner part of the palace is located the chapel dedicated to St. Archangel Michael parliament. The miraculous icon of the Holy Virgin Mary known as Vinča bezdinska is placed in the chapel as a comfort and protection of the faithful.

















3. The Roman Catholic Cathedral of St Gerhard



Built in period 1860-1863, this is the largest cathedral in Vojvodina. The church is basilica equipped with carved furniture, decorated with mural paintings and altar, stained with glasses and sculptures The church also contains an organ with two manuals and 52 registries, made at the beginning of the 20th century in the manufacture of Leoplda Vegštajna in Timisoara, and kept the guild flags to the end of the 19th century.

Wine route:

Wine route is spiritual adventure, in the honor of the rich and exciting tradition of grapes growing in this rich area, which awake all the senses of wine lovers, made by the traditional old masters. Experience is to visit and wine tasting in wine cellars. There are hospitable hosts, who their old cellars turned into a place where you can enjoy in wine degustation, taste and rich delicates of this region, and the sounds of traditional instruments tell diverse stories.

The route of the "way of wine":

- visit to the winery and cellars "Vinik" in Vršac
- ride through the vineyards to the village Gudurica (with a long winemaking tradition)
- Visit to the "Other house" picnic in the vineyards at 50 m from the Romanian border
- visit to the "Cellar of friendship" in Gudurica cellar from the 1871.
- wine tasting in the "Berovo cellar" or wine degustation in one of the many wine cellars in the
