
PROGRAMME STATE OF THE ART



- 3 Calls for Proposals (plus Restricted Call for Strategic Projects) already launched and projects selected and approved for funding
- 94 projects approved along Calls 1-3
 - 1st Call: 29 projects
 - 2nd Call: 37 projects
 - 3rd Call: 28 projects

Restricted Call for Strategic projects: 7 projects approved - currently under negotiation

~ 83 % of the total ERDF Programme budget already allocated (around 192 Mio € ERDF funds) in Calls 1-3 → amounting to ~92 % with the indicative allocation of the Restricted Call for Strategic projects

BASIC PROJECT REQUIREMENTS - PARTNERS



Characteristics of eligible partners:

- •National, regional and local public authorities
- Public equivalent bodies
- Private institutions
- International institutions

Minimum partnership requirements:

- *At least three financing partners,
- •From at least three countries and
- Being at least two of the partners located in EU CENTRAL EUROPE regions

Location of partners/activities:

- •Core thematic activities to be implemented within the CENTRAL EUROPE area
- *If clear benefit for the regions of the CENTRAL EUROPE Programme area, possibility to involve partners/carry out activities in the EU territory outside the CE cooperation area (20% flexibility) as well as in third countries (10% flexibility)

LEAD PARTNER REQUIREMENTS



Located in the EU CENTRAL EUROPE area*:

- National, regional and local public authorities
- Public Equivalent Bodies
- International Organisations acting under national law
- Private institutions (only for projects submitted under Priority 1)
- * for IT and DE assimilated partners can also act as Lead Partners

PROJECT SIZE, DURATION AND FUNDING



Recommended project size:

1 to 2,5 million EUR total budget

Recommended project duration

Between 24 - 30 months (latest acceptable end date 31 December 2014)

Co-financing rates

Up to 75%: Austria, Germany, Italy

Up to 85%: Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland, Slovakia, Slovenia

Up to 75%: EU partners located outside the EU CENTRAL EUROPE area

RESPECT OF EU POLICIES



Project proposals have to respect:

- Equal opportunities
- Protection and improvement of the environment
- Public procurement rules
- State Aid

(it is not the legal status of the partner but the nature of the activities that it intends to implement that determines whether the State Aid discipline is applicable or not)

INVOLVEMENT OF PRIVATE INSTITUTIONS AS LEAD APPLICANTS



The financial capacity of the <u>private Lead Applicants in Priority 1</u> projects and its capacity to manage the project budget must be demonstrated:

- a) Additional documents to be submitted, including the filling-in of a Simplified Financial Statement;
- b) Additional check on their financial capacity will be performed (criteria as defined in the Application Manual);
- c) In case of approval, the private Lead Partner will be asked to provide, before the signature of the subsidy contract, proof that a financial guarantee is in force.

Please note that in case the Lead Applicant within Priority 1 declares being a Public Equivalent Body, but after the checks on legal status results being a private institution, the project proposal will be considered as not eligible.
